## Coyote Kit *Skull Activity*

Which teeth do you use to chew up the apple?</li><li>● Are there any other parts of the coyote skull other than the jaw that are similar to a human skull? What are the differences between them?</li><li>● Why do you think the coyote teeth are arranged the same in both animals? (incisor, then canine, then molars)</li></ul>
